

**Richlawn City Commission
Minutes of the Regular Meeting
November 21, 2011**

The regular meeting of the Richlawn City Council was held on Monday, November 21, 2011, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Mayor Pat Coomes and Commissioners Alicia Nordmann, Andrew Renda, Joe Bohannon, and Henry Thoben, along with City Clerk/Treasurer Jeff Barrick and City Attorney Steve Porter. Mayor Coomes called the meeting to order at 7:29 p.m.

A. Clerk/Treasurer's Report (Monthly Balance Sheet & Income Stmt, Actual/Budget comparison, Tax Summary, Bills)

- Mr. Barrick presented the bills to be paid in November:
