

**Richlawn City Commission
Minutes of the Regular Meeting
March 19, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Richlawn City Council was held on Monday, March 19, 2012, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Mayor Pat Coomes and Commissioners Andrew Renda, Joe Bohannon, and Henry Thoben, along with City Clerk/Treasurer Jeff Barrick and City Attorney Steve Porter. Commissioner Alicia Nordmann was not present. District 9 Louisville Metro Councilwoman Tina Ward-Pugh was also in attendance. Mayor Coomes called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

A. Mr. Barrick presented the bills to be paid in March:

- Commissioner Renda made a motion to pay the bills, Commissioner Bohannon seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

B. Minutes from February Meeting

- Commissioner Renda made a motion to approve the minutes from the February meeting, Commissioner Thoben seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

C. Communications

1. **Gazette:** Mayor Coomes will speak to the next person to deliver the Gazette to not lay the flyer on porches.
 - a. Commissioner Thoben suggested sending a copy of the Gazette to the City of St. Matthews, Beechwood Village, and Councilwoman Tina Ward-Pugh.

D. Tree Ordinance: No new interest

E. Shelbyville road sidewalks: Mayor Coomes stated the City of St. Matthews needs to purchase an easement before construction on sidewalks can begin.

F. Councilwoman Tina Ward-Pugh: The councilwoman introduced herself and explained that she wants to establish a relationship with Richlawn. Richlawn is one of two 6th class cities in her district. She is willing to be involved as little or as much as the council would like. Mayor Coomes stated the city would like to be involved in any discussions of the Hubbards Lane expansion project.

G. Attorney Update: Mr. Porter stated a Kroger fuel station is going in the old Chevron location on Hubbards Lane. They are installing all lighting to the city's specifications. There were no objections.

1. Commissioner Renda introduced the first reading of Building Ordinance 2012-01. The ordinance modifies the previous building ordinance. Council members were asked to review the ordinance and provide Mr. Porter with any changes.
2. Commissioner Thoben is to provide a copy of the current Richlawn Building permit to Mr. Barrick for revising and publication on the city's website.

H. Resident Concerns:

1. **Camper:** A resident from Beechwood Village complained about a camper that is in the backyard of a Richlawn resident on Hubbards Lane. Mr. Porter stated the city cannot do anything about it.
2. **Break-ins:**
 - a. Two individuals have been charged in the recent break-ins.
 - b. Commissioner Renda stated he has received no feedback from residents on the article in the Gazette about establishing a Neighborhood Watch Program.
 - c. **Graffiti:** Mayor Coomes had the graffiti on the brick wall on the entrance of the city for \$750. Commissioner Renda made a motion to pay the painters when the invoice is received. Commissioner Bohannon seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

1. Mayor Coomes stated the next meeting will be held on Monday April 16, 2012 at 7:30 PM at Old National Bank on Hubbards Lane
2. Commissioner Bohannon made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 PM; it was seconded by Commissioner Renda and passed unanimously.
