

**Richlawn City Commission
Minutes of the Regular Meeting
June 18, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Richlawn City Council was held on Monday, June 18, 2012, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Mayor Pat Coomes and Commissioners Andrew Renda, Joe Bohannon, Alicia Nordmann, and Henry Thoben, along with City Clerk/Treasurer Jeff Barrick and City Attorney Steve Porter. Mayor Coomes called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

A. Mr. Barrick presented the bills to be paid in June:

- Commissioner Renda made a motion to pay the bills, Commissioner Bohannon seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

B. Minutes from May Meeting

- Commissioner Nordmann made a motion to approve the minutes from the May meeting, Commissioner Renda seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

C. Tree Program:

- No New Updates – Commissioner Bohannon published an article in the Summer Gazette

D. Gazette: The Summer Gazette went to the printer today. It will be delivered Friday or Saturday. There will be two inserts, one for the new recycling calendar and the other is the recently passed building ordinance. Mayor Coomes will discuss proper delivery practices with whoever delivers the Gazettes.

E. FY2013 Tax & Budget Ordinances:

- The only change to the budget was an additional \$20,000 for sidewalks along Shelbyville Road. Discussion ensued. The sidewalks along Shelbyville Road will cost approximately \$89K based on a proposal from Dirk Gowin. A contract has not been presented to the City Council and no formal discussions have taken place between Richlawn and St. Matthews. The City Council would like more information regarding the sidewalks before paying for the sidewalks.
- Commissioner Renda made a motion to approve Budget Ordinance 2012-02. Commissioner Nordmann seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Commissioner Renda made a motion to approve Tax Rate Ordinance 2012-03. Commissioner Nordmann seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Commissioner Renda made a motion to approve Franchise Tax Ordinance 2012-04. Commissioner Nordmann seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

F. Attorney Updates: Presented Budget, Tax Rate, & Franchise Tax Ordinances.

G. Other items or resident concerns:

- **Rumpke:** The new recycling program will begin on July 1. The old recycling containers will be picked up on June 25 and the new containers will be dropped off the last week of June. The first recycling pickup will be July 9.
- **Newspaper:** Commissioner Bohannon stated there is a new Courier Journal delivery person.
- **4th of July Parade:** Commissioner Renda stated the Neighborhood Association has approximately \$200 left over from the 2011 Fall Festival and would provide that money to help with the 4th of July Parade which will be on Tuesday July 3 at 6:30 at 220 Don Allen Road. Commissioner Thoben suggested catering some events toward the older residents in the city. Commissioner Nordmann asked for suggestions. Discussion ensued.
- **Soliciting:** Mayor Coomes stated he has contacted the businesses putting advertisements on residents' doors and porches and has asked them to stop.
- **Rumpke:** Mr. Barrick stated Richlawn has signed a one year extension with Rumpke to continue trash & recycling pickup.

H. Adjourn

1. Mayor Coomes stated the next meeting will be held on Monday July 16, 2012 at 7:30 PM at Old National Bank on Hubbards Lane
2. Commissioner Renda made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 PM; it was seconded by Commissioner Bohannon and passed unanimously.
