

**Richlawn City Commission  
Minutes of the Regular Meeting  
August 20, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Richlawn City Council was held on Monday, August 20, 2012, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Mayor Pat Coomes and Commissioners Alicia Nordmann, Andrew Renda, Joe Bohannon, and Henry Thoben, along with Clerk/Treasurer Jeff Barrick and City Attorney Steve Porter.
