

**Richlawn City Commission  
Minutes of the Special Meeting  
August 4, 2014**

The special meeting of the Richlawn City Council was held on Monday, August 4, 2014, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Mayor Pat Coomes, Commissioners Dirk Gowin, Roger Rymarz, Henry Thoben and Rae Taylor, along with Clerk/Treasurer Jeff Barrick. Mayor Coomes called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

- A. Commissioner Taylor made a motion to approve Ordinance 2014-04, an ordinance relating to seeking annexation by the City of St. Matthews, KY, of the entire area of the city of Richlawn, KY.
  - Commissioner Gowin seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- B. Commissioner Taylor made a motion to publish the approved ordinance in the Courier Journal. Commissioner Rymarz seconded the motion, Commissioner Gowin abstained from voting and the motion passed 3-0.
- C. Mr. Barrick will take the ordinance to Kinko's to be mailed to all Richlawn property owners. By publishing the ordinance, all Richlawn residents will be notified of the passing of this ordinance. Commissioner Taylor will hand deliver the ordinance to the St. Matthews City Clerk on Tuesday, August 5.
- D. Commissioner Rymarz made a motion to adjourn at 7:08 PM. Commissioner Gowin seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
