

**Richlawn City Commission
Minutes of the Regular Meeting
April 17, 2015**

The regular meeting of the Richlawn Commission was held on Monday, April 17th, 2017, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Mayor Alicia Nordmann, Commissioners Ian Cassidy, Joe Meyn, Andrew Carpenter, Steve Wilkerson, and City Attorney Steve Porter. Treasurer Daniel Sullivan was not present. There were no guests/Residents in attendance at the meeting.

C. Resident Record Keeping – Ian Cassidy

- Ian Cassidy reported that the storage unit was still in place and efforts were being made by he and Commissioner Carpenter to review contents.
- The Commission decided to try and cancel the storage unit by end of May to save this cost.

D. Property Improvements Ordinance- Joe Meyn

- Commissioner Meyn stated a local resident had a fence that was approved in the past month.

E. Resident Communications – Andrew Carpenter

- Commissioner Carpenter also discussed the storage project and he has filtered through much of the material.
- He also contacted some local historical groups to see if they had interest in any of the older city documents. He was told that the earlier material may be of interest.

F. Physical Asset Management – Steve Wilkerson

- Commissioner Wilkerson discussed the repair that was completed by Harrod Electric on the front entrance lights. These lights have a sensor that was failing and it was replaced on both units. Now, they do not stay on during the day.
- He also reported that a few other lights in the neighborhood had to be repaired by LG&E. One light was staying on during the day and another one was not coming on at night. LG&E responded and all lights are in working order at this time.

G. Code Enforcement – George Stewart

- The Code enforcement officer was not present.

H. City Attorney – Stephen Porter

- City Attorney Stephen Porter presented three new City Ordinances for review. A sign ordinance, amended parking and rental property are being considered.

I. Mayor Report – Alicia Nordmann

- Mayor Nordmann discussed the recent patrols by Lt. Cabrera. He has not seen much speeding or stop sign violations during his visits. But, he is in a marked car and probably effects traffic in that regard. His presence is appreciated and he will continue to keep an eye out on these issues.

J. New Business

- Commissioner Wilkerson will seek some landscaping ideas for the areas that exists after the trees that were removed from the front entrance landscape. He will get some ideas and bring those to the May meeting for discussion.
