

**Richlawn City Commission
Minutes of the Special Meeting
February 13, 2018**

A Special meeting of the Richlawn Commission was held on Monday, February 13, 2018, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Commissioners Steve Wilkerson, Ian Cassidy, Andrew Carpenter, Jeremy Clark, City Treasurer/Clerk Daniel Sullivan. Mayor Nordmann and Attorney Steve Porter were not present. Residents Rae and Dianne Taylor were also present.

Commissioner Wilkerson called the meeting to order at 6 p.m.

Treasurer Sullivan discussed the purpose of the special meeting and the necessity for the tax rate change. The decrease was necessary because the Jefferson County Property Valuation Administration has reassessed the value of several properties within our city limits. The new assessments have increased total property values within Richlawn by more than \$4 Million dollars. Therefore, the decrease was necessary to remain in compliance with Kentucky Revised Statute 132.027 (3). The statute limits revenue increases from Real Property taxes collected to no more than 4% over the previous year.

Commissioner Wilkerson motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-1 to reduce the tax rate for Richlawn from .13 to .125 cents per \$100. Seconded by Commissioner Carpenter. Motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Wilkerson motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-2 to amend city budget and reflect the new tax rate. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Clark. Motion passed unanimously.
