

**Richlawn City Commission
Minutes of the Regular Meeting
September 17, 2018**

The regular meeting of the Richlawn Commission was held on Monday, September 17, 2018, at the Old National Bank on Shelbyville Road & Hubbards Lane. Present were Mayor Alicia Nordmann, Commissioners Steve Wilkerson, Ian Cassidy, Andrew Carpenter, Jeremy Clark, and Code Enforcement Officer George Stewart.

Mayor Alicia Nordmann called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

A. Resident/Guest Open Forum –

Rae Taylor – Check in on city business. Discussed drain inlet at the edge of his property.
Matt Brotski – Question about privacy fence and tree along property edge.

B. Code Enforcement Officer Report –

- Discussed this period's violations (none) and follow-up with residents (three reported issues).
