

Richlawn Meeting August 16, 2021

1. Resident/Guest Forum:

Max Atherton 4199 Blenheim – concerned about overgrowth behind his house. Lot is owned by Marshal Reality. Daniel will reach out to Marshal about paying for the trimming and Dianne will get quote from Greenscapes.

Sam Rymarz – Eagle Scout Project – presented the plan for corner of Blenheim. Commission voted to approve the project and donate \$500 towards the plan. Sam will return next month with more information.

Bill Vest – 4119 Blenheim – asked about addition to his house and expressed concern about abandoned house. City of Louisville has sent citations to the abandoned house. Corey to follow up.

2. Sheepdog Security:

Sgt Tourinho expressed concern about youths breaking into cars – mostly unlocked. Remind residents to lock cars and watch for unknown people roaming around neighborhood

3. City Clerk:

Bills and July minutes presented and Corey motioned to pay bills and approve minutes – Paul second. Daniel and Steve will work on decreasing tax base and relief funds.

4. City Attorney:

Steve will draft an ordinance for non-soliciting in the neighborhood.

5. Code Enforcement Officer – citations issued and lighting issues in 123 Gibson

6. Commissioner Brotzge – shared information via email – lighting issues and construction projects. Shared a residents desire to put a playground at Ledyard Field. The Commission voted no on project, citing concerns with upkeep, noise to the residents on Ledyard, and price.

7. Commissioner DeVore - trying to find residents to take over the Richlawn Neighborhood Assoc with no takers. Have asked on Nextdoor, Facebook and Gazette.

8. Commissioner Downs – Over 100 residents have signed up for EZ Texting. He is continuing to update the website and handbook.

9. Commissioner Phillippe – Gazette has been delivered. 4193 abandoned house updates- inspector has visited and cited resident. The house is on list for city to send a crew to clean up.

10. Mayor Carpenter – Hubbards Ln update-property is being acquired but one property is not selling. Once all property is purchased a spring date for starting project.

11. New Business-Spending COVID funds – possible technology updates and purchases for meetings.
