

City of Richlawn Minutes June 20, 2022

Meeting called to order at 6:30 – In attendance: Corey, Matt, Dianne, Andy, Daniel, Steve

- Open Forum – Guest Matthew Nentwick- parking concerns at 210 Don Allen – parked there most days and blocks him from backing into his driveway. Guest Rae Taylor-some concerns about driveway of J. Anderson-Matt will follow up with him about the driveway concerns
- City Clerk – Daniel Sullivan:

He will send out an updated sheet with all the bills and checks on them. Motion to pay bills-Dianne and second the motion Corey.

Budget review- add \$5000 to budget for webpage, \$2500 for tree canopy, \$1000 for landscaping (fuel surcharge), Commissioner and Mayor pay increase for the new incoming Commission, add money to Anytime for fuel surcharge. Motion to pay bills-Dianne and second the motion Corey.

Taxation – still needs additional numbers for the taxation and will share hopefully at next meeting.
- City Attorney-Steve Porter:

Working on ordinance for house maintenance (clean yard) and grass (native plants) in the neighborhood.
- Commissioner Brotzge:

No new construction projects. City wide arborist ideas-ask neighbors who would like to opt in and have an arborist inspect all their trees. Then will get an arborist to check out the houses who would like trees inspected and the resident can then choose what they want to do with any ideas on their trees.
- Commissioner DeVore:

Front entrance lighting is complete. There are a few signs missing in the neighborhood and will get them replaced.
- Commissioner Phillippe:

Street repairs will take place soon. 4193 Blenheim should be receiving fines from the city. Working on ideas for the Gazette and will send on email to approve. Needs the names for the Beautiful Lawn Contest.
- Mayor- Andy Carpenter:

Hubbard's Lane is relocating gas and utilities and will be at least a year before construction starts. Will get with Corey on the Gazette ideas. Looking into ordinance for artificial noise machine in the neighborhood.
